To make reservations or to book a vacation plan, complete and mail the form at the back of this guide or call (407) 824-8000, (Effective July 1, 1988, the telephone number is (407) W-Disney.) 8:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Eastern Time. The Central Reservations Office is open seven days a week. We suggest you call after 6:00 p.m. or on weekends.

All prices and check-in/check-out times are subject to change without notice.

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT In the Walt Disney World Resort Hotels, check-in time is 3:00 p.m.; check-out time is 11:00 a.m.

Fort Wilderness Campground Resort check-in time is 1:00 p.m. (3:00 p.m. for trailer home rentals); check-out time is 11:00 a.m. Disney Village Resort check-in time is 4:00 p.m.; check-out time is 11:00 a.m. Club Suite guests check in at the Conference Center. All other Disney Village Resort guests check in at the Reception Center front desk.

Guests arriving prior to check-in time may pre-register and receive their resort I.D. cards. With the resort I.D. card and prior authorization, guests may charge purchases in shops, restaurants, lounges, recreational areas and other facilities at the resort hotels, Epcot Center, Fort Wilderness Campground Resort, and Walt Disney World Village.



#### TRAVELING TO THE WALT DISNEY WORLD RESOR

Airlines: Both Orlando International Airport, approximately 20 miles from the Walt Disney World Resort, and Tampa International Airport, approximately 75 miles away, are served by many major airlines, including Delta, the Official Airline of Walt Disney World.

Buses: Greyhound, the Official Motor Coach Carrier of the Walt Disney World Resort, provides regular connecting service between the Walt Disney World Resort and Greyhound's entire transportation network. Local service from downtown Orlando is also available, with schedules dependent on Epcot Center and Magic Kingdom operating hours. Van and motor coach service is available daily between Orlando International Airport and the Walt Disney World Resort.

Car Rental: National Car Rental is the Official Car Rental Company of the Walt Disney World Resort and Disneyland. To reserve your car, call (800) 328-4567; in

Minnesota, (800) 830-2345.

Traveling by Car: The Walt Disney World Resort is located off Interstate 4 west of the Florida Turnpike. Motorists traveling I-95 or U.S. Highway 1 should take I-4 west to the Walt Disney World exits. Motorists traveling 1-75 should take the Florida Turnpike to the Kissimmee-St. Cloud interchange, which connects U.S. Highway 192 and the Walt Disney World Resort. If you're traveling by car on southbound I-75, before you reach the Florida Turnpike you can stop at the Official Walt Disney World Information Center, Exit 68 in Ocala, for advance accommodations reservations, admission tickets, and the latest Disney merchandise.

There is a same-day nominal parking fee at either the Epcot Center or Magic Kingdom Auto Plaza. Special areas are provided for handicapped parking. A Transportation Guide is provided in each resort guest's check-in folder which provides detailed schedules. These guides are also available at the Guest Services location at each resort.




